**Rt Revd Libby Lane, Bishop of Stockport**  
**Rabbi Robyn Ashworth Steen, Associate Rabbi, Manchester Reform Congregation**

- In 2015, Libby Lane was the first woman to be appointed a Bishop in the Church of England when she was made Bishop of Stockport
- In 2017, Robyn Ashworth-Steen was the first woman to be appointed a Rabbi in a Manchester synagogue when she became Associate Rabbi of Manchester Reform Congregation in Jacksons Row
- This year marks the centenary of women being given the right to vote in, and stand for, elections in this country. They reflect together in conversation on the issues raised by this anniversary
