Worship

Worship is central to who we are as a Church. Our regular Service pattern is as follows – please check our website or get in touch for details of activities for children and special Services, particularly at Christmas and Easter.

Daily Services

Morning Prayer is usually said at 9.00am on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays in the Church. The Church building is open throughout the day for people to visit and pray.

On Wednesdays we have a Communion Service in the Chapel of St Peter's House at 10am.

Sunday Services

8.30am Holy Communion (a said Service)

10.00am Our Principal Service with hymns and Choir. This is usually a Communion Service.

11.30am Once a month we have an interactive family Service aimed especially at young families. Our Family Praise Service usually takes place on the 2nd Sunday of each month (do check for details in May and August).

6.30pm Our Evening Service. This generally takes the form of traditional Evensong on the 1st and 2nd Sundays each month, with said Evensong on the 3rd Sunday, an informal Service on the 4th Sunday, and a Service in the Taize tradition when there is a 5th Sunday.
